“For the St. Petersburg – Finland Friendship Monument”

INTRODUCTION

The Open international competition among students of architecturally-building HIGH SCHOOLS of St.-Petersburg and Finland for the best project of the monument symbolizing friendly relations between St.-Petersburg and Finland is spent on the basis of the commission of the Governor of St.-Petersburg V. I. Matvienko at the initiative of the LLC «Technopolis - St.-Petersburg» (further – competition).

Participants should offer in the specified terms the sketch of the project of the monument symbolizing friendly relations between St.-Petersburg and Finland for the subsequent installation in park zone, near the building «PULKOVO TECHNOLIS» to the address: St.-Petersburg, Pulkovskoe shosse, 30/4, the Moscovskij area, site 2 (the Leningrad party) (further – monument).

PROGRAMM

1. THE IDEA OF THE PROJECT

The «idea of the project» is unity of the town-planning, art problems united by bright artistic image.

Participants of competition are offered to express the idea of friendly relations between St.-Petersburg and Finland by means of architecture or sculpture.

The project of the monument symbolizing friendly relations between St.-Petersburg and Finland, should be inseparably linked with place of its placing, consider town-planning situation, giving access to the monument, its perception from key points of square, light image of monument during evening and night time.

Organizers of competition hope, that young sculptors and architects will take part in such competition and they will receive fruitful and perspective results.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE COMPETITIVE SITE LOCATION

The Monument will be create in the park near the building of the Technopolis (Pulkovskoe shosse, 30/4) (the situational plan of M 1:500 according to the appendix).

The park is located along Pulkovskoe shosse. The area of the site is 3784. From the East, South and West the park is limited by roads.

Now the considered site is free from building, is planted trees and shrubs, long-boled trees are absent.

Site relief equal with bias along Pulkovskoe shosse with slight increase in South side with difference of heights in absolute marks BSH (the Baltic system of heights) from 17,30 m to 17,605 m.

Now there is a reconstruction of existing accomplishment. It is planned to organize in the centre of a site a platform with a stuffed covering. The central platform incorporates with roads by foot paths, with a stuffed covering and inserts from a tree and tiles. It will be flower beds and ornamental shrubs will be on lawns.

The monument is planning to install in the central platform in the park.

3. PROJECT OBJECTIVES AND TASKS

The competitive project objectives include:

- a creation of expressional architectural image, technically original to convey the concept of the monument

The tasks of the competitive project are:

- to develop the plan of the park, devoted to Russian-Finnish friendship
- envisage design and functional links between the Monument and The built-up areas both existing and prospective and the square
- to offer scale plastically expressive decision of a monument
- professional performance

The executive secretary of the competition is obligated to register application forms, give necessary information, answer the questions, check up competitive projects by program and conditions of the competition.

5. COMPETITION TIMELINE

Total duration of the competition – 2,5 months.

6. ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to:

- qualified young architects, designers and city planners or creative groups, from St-Petersburg and Finland (not older than 35);
- students of the Fine Arts and Architectural High Schools from St-Petersburg and Finland.

8. PARTICIPANTS REGISTRATION

8.1. The participants of the competition must get registered through sending an application by e-mail to the address of Executive Secretary of the Competition.

8.2. Executive Secretary of the Competition confirms reception of an application and register participants.

8.3. After the end of registration the participant will receive materials required for design in text, photo and graphical format by e-mail from Executive Secretary.

8.4. The registration fee is not provided.

9. COMPETITION PRIZE POOL:

- I place - 5 000 euro + a trip for two persons to Finland or St.-Petersburg for 2 days, including hotel, transport expenses (train) and a dinner.
- II place - 2500 euro,
- III place - 1 000 euro.

10. DESCRIPTION OF COMPETITIVE DESIGN:

1. Explanatory note, maximum 3 pages of text including basic idea of the project, materials, architectural, constructive and engineering decisions;
2. General plan of the Square, where the monument will be placed, with proposals on planning concept and landscape arrangement of the area, scale 1:500;
3. Facades and perspective view or photomontage up to the author;
4. Model of the monument in a soft material (M 1:10) (up to the author);
5. The information about participant (participants) of competition in the sealed envelope: a surname, a name, number of the bank account, full nameplate data, a home address and phones.

11. REQUIREMENTS TO EXECUTION OF COMPETITIVE DESIGN

11.1. All demonstrational materials should be attached to light plotting boards 60*80 cm (no more than two) and should be copy in electronic format on CD-ROM and send by e-mail to Executive secretary.

11.2. Competitive works should be sent to the **address** of the Organizer of competition (**The Committee for City Planning and Architecture: 2, Lomonosova sq., St. Petersburg, 191011, Russia**) by mail or should be bring **15th of September from 9.00 to 17.00** by participant personally to that address.

11.3. Competitive works should be sent under a device of six Arabic numerals. The device should be placed on the package, envelops and in the top right hand corner on the rear of each plotting board.

11.4. Postal expenses should be borne by the participants.

11.5. The envelop with personal data about authors will be opened only upon resolution of the Jury on awarding the given design with a prize.

11.6. The competitive designs coming after September, 15th, 2010 after 17.00 p. m., will not considered.

12. COMPETITIVE DESIGN EVALUATION CRITERIA

12.1. Figurative and aesthetic expressiveness of a monument, originality of an author's plan.

12.2. Achievement of comfortable expressive city environment by means of landscape architecture, urban design and sculpture.

12.3. The scale of a composition and surrounding building should be in harmony.

12.4. Conformity of a material of a monument to the idea of the monument and image of the space.

12.5. Possibility of realization of a monument taking into account cost characteristics.

12.6. Professional performance.

13. INTIAL MATERIALS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE COMPETITION PARTICIPANTS

13.1. Program and Conditions of the competition;

13.2. Site location plan, scale 1:500, AutoCAD;

13.3. Basic plan;

13.4. Developed views.

14. COMPETITION JURY AND EXPERTS WORK

14.1. The Competition is to be held in one stage.

14.2. The Jury of the Competition will consist of 10-11 persons. The Experts group will consist of 3-4 persons.

14.3. The Experts Group will carry out expert examination of the competitive designs. The Experts Group will include expert: sculptor and architect.

14.4. Experts will analyze the competitive works on conformity of the competitive documentation, full value of disclosing of problems, on quality of design and plastic decisions, etc.

14.5. Opinion signed by the Experts will be handed by Executive Secretary to the Competition Jury.

14.6. The expert opinion has recommendatory character.

14.7. Based on the results of competitive designs evaluation the Jury will identify 3 best designs, which are awarded by the monetary awards specified in item 9 of the present conditions. The Jury may also identify several extra works, the authors of which will be awarded with certificates of honor and souvenirs from the Competition promoters.

14.8. The Jury will adopt resolution at final meetings by simple majority vote.

14.9. Protocol of the Jury's resolution and the Experts' Opinions will be prepared by Executive Secretary of the Competition. After its signing by all the members of the Jury, the resolution of the Jury will be final and not subject to revision. Protocol of the Jury's resolution is the basis for payment monetary compensations to the authors of the prize designs according to item 9 of the present conditions

15. ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

15.1. Results of the Competitive will be announced to the winners and awardees by Executive Secretary of the Competition.

15.2. The winners and awardees will be invited to the final ceremony of the competition. The place and date will be announced later.

15.3. The Customer of the Competition will transfer money prizes to the authors of the prize designs to their bank account, according to item 9.

16. SPECIAL CONDITION

16.1. Anonymity of the participants is guaranteed for the period of the Competition. Compliance with necessary procedures will be supervised by Executive Secretary of the Competition.

16.2. Copyright to design solution submitted in the framework of the Competition is protected by the provision of the Russian laws and international legal acts.
